### **1. Length of Study**

#### 4. Publications Requirements

Doctoral candidates must meet one of the following publication requirements:

(1) Publish at least one academic paper in SSCI or A & HCI indexed journals.

Candidate should be the first author. Or mentor is the first author and the candidate is the second author. The first author's affiliation should be East China Normal University.

(2) Publish at least one academic paper in the first-rated key journals. Candidate should be the first author. Or mentor is the first author and the candidate is the second author. The first author's affiliation should be East China Normal University.

(3) Publish at least two academic papers in CSSCI-indexed journals. Candidate

should be the first author.

### **5. Other requirements**

Other requirements for the doctoral students are:

- (1) *Annual report*
- (2) completion of a non-credit course “Research Ethics and Academic Norms”
- (3) Qualification exam
- (4) academic events (at least 30 sessions)
